ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible for the Vice-Chancellors scholarship students must

- · Apply directly enter either Year 1 or Year 2 of an undergraduate course at RGU
- Hold an offer from Robert Gordon University for a full time on campus undergraduate course
- · Be a self-funding student
- Join the September intake. If starting in January, the scholarship would apply to the following September
- · Be willing to act as an ambassador for RGU
